Candidate Thomas- Gives a speech, thanks the Executive Board for nomination, talks about previous Attorney General inspiration, talks about his qualifications in CSUN, RHA, and founding of his club. Expands on idea of workshops on Governing Documents

President Odunze- Thanks candidate for speech and explains the absence of candidate Gerwaski, states the Executive Board will still be seeing him as a candidate, moves on to candidate Ordonio
