
Jacob Rothrock

I joined the rebel scholars to gain insight and make connections with various people and majors across the UNLV campus.








Major: Healthcare Administration & Policy & Political Science






Nirel Gonzalez - Montes






Elizabeth Fakoya

I applied for RR to get the most out of my time here and to expand my skill set while interacting with new types of people from different fields!






Ashley E. Devin




Kyle Yeung




Heidee Pavon




Harvard Atimalala Tagovailoa

I applied to the Rebels R.I.S.E Scholar program in order to get more involved with different organizations on campus and to meet like minded people who are focused on personal growth.






Daisy Ruiz-Lopez




Acorey Sims
