SENATE BILL 55-128

AN ACT TO CREATE A ONE-TIME SPONSORSHIP TO ENHANCE SAFETY WITH BIKE AND SCOOTER LOCKS

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

WHEREAS, Section 04 under Chapter 1200 of Title XII of the CSUN Bylaws establishes the ability to “regulate sponsorship funding by establishing guidelines for applicants, approving or disapproving of all applications, and managing ongoing sponsorships”; **AND**

WHEREAS, the University Initiatives committee (under the Legislative Branch of CSUN) serves with the purposes of improving the UNLV campus and community, addressing and advocating for undergraduate student interests, needs, and concerns related to (but not limited to) health, safety, diversity, social justice, and sustainability; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN sponsorships play a vital role in supporting essential UNLV entities and their operations that positively impact the undergraduate student body; **AND**

WHEREAS, the UNLV University Police Department seeks one-time sponsorship funding in order to support the undergraduate student body with the financial cost for providing bike and scooter locks; **AND**

WHEREAS, the CSUN University Initiatives Committee shall review the request on September 25th, 2025 during UI 55-11; **AND**

WHEREAS, UNLV University Police Department, after being seen by the University Initiatives Committee on UI 55-11, shall have been approved for an amount not to exceed \$5,000;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED that CSUN shall appropriate an amount not to exceed \$5,000 from the CSUN FY 2025-2026 “New One-Time Sponsorships” budget, as outlined in the University Police Department budget provided in addendum A, in order to provide a one-time sponsorship to the UNLV University Police Department to fund bike/scooter locks for undergraduate students, thereby enhancing safety through reducing theft and easing financial costs.

ADDENDUM A

Options for ABUS (abususa.com) locks for this initiative:

1. **Bordo 6000K/90 ST – retail \$129.99, starting cost 45, with breaks on quantity, flyer attached (this may be a reach but it is the best price we have ever been able to offer with a MAP at 89.99) roughly 144 locks.**



2. **Catena 6806/110 chain; 6mm chain, 110 cm long. A huge leap up from a cable but still a lightweight chain. Cost \$30.12 or roughly 166 locks**



3. Tresor 1385/85 combination chain; 7mm chain, 85cm long, cost \$32.59 each, or about 153 locks.
