**AN ACT TO AMEND THE CSUN BYLAW CHAPTER 301**

**WHEREAS**, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

**WHEREAS**, it is in the interest of the Senate to ensure that the Judicial Branch operates with clarity, transparency, and consistency through updated bylaws; **AND**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 301 of the CSUN Bylaws outlines the structure and responsibilities of the Judicial Branch, and thus must reflect the most current and accurate procedures; **AND**

**THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED**, that the CSUN Bylaws Chapter 301 be amended to require that the Judicial Council publish and present its Operating Policy each semester without necessitating a bylaw amendment for future changes, as reflected in **ADDENDUM A**.

## **CHAPTER 301: JUDICIAL BRANCH**

### **SECTION 01: JUDICIAL COUNCIL**

A. In accordance with the CSUN Constitution, the Judicial Council shall publish an Operating Policy at their first meeting of each semester and present it to the Senate at the first meeting in both October and in March.
