Chair Casanova- Does not know for sure. States if donations were received they would be a formal endorser.

Advisor Dow- Refers to original election expenditures and encourages to look at it. Supplemental material must be added prior to meeting.

Complainant Kelechi Odunze- States they have nothing further to say.

Respondent Josephine Shaw- States HOSA is a formal endorser. States drinks were just left over at the club. Requests a breakdown of the expenditure.

Chair Casanova- Refers to Election Costs as found in the supplemental materials. Refers to complaint #8 itself.

Commissioner Destiny Hernandez- Asks if they considered HOSA a non UNLV entity.

Respondent Josephine Shaw- States HOSA is an RSO. States the funds to buy the drinks was not from CSUN.

Advisor Dow- Refers to the sheet as found in Election Costs which breaks down spending from each ticket.

Respondent Sayla Daily- States they were unaware of overspending. Asks if this is still a valid complaint due to timing.

Chair Casanova- States if the infraction occurred on April 10th and the complaint was received on April 10th at 8:37 pm, the complaint is valid.

Complainant Princessa Tolano- States they kept track of the funds and that gifts should be added to the expenditure form.

Complainant Sharon Flores- States the expenditure form would not be complete.

Complainant Kelechi Odunze- States complaint was posted the same day as the expenditure forms were released.

Chair Casanova- Encourages discussion behind the penalty of infraction.

Commissioner Yasmin Graves- States it would be a penalty of one strike due to not turning in the form in the allotted time.
