Discussion And Approval of Executive Bill 55-07 AN ACT TO AMEND THE CSUN CONSTITUTION AND CLARIFY THE STRUCTURE OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH.** President Odunze requests time for the approval of EB 55-07 as attached in the accompanying supplemental materials. *President Odunze thanked the committee for the time. Invites AG Rejas to explain how bylaw changes are made.*

*AG Rejas explains how changes are made.*

*President Odunze explains the changes to the bylaws and the changes wished to be made in this bill. Explains changes to executive officers and who are executive officers. Elaborates further on changes, to clarify titles and who is executive officer, and who is a part of the executive cabinet. Cabinet members would only need 24 credits finished at UNLV, rather than the 48 for executive officers.*

Discussion And Approval of Executive Bill 55-08 AN ACT TO AMEND THE CSUN CONSTITUTION AND REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL MEMBERS.** President Odunze requests time for the approval of EB 55-08 as attached in the accompanying supplemental materials. Deliberation and amendments to the Executive Bill can occur under this agenda item.

*President Odunze explains that the executive board has had a meeting with the Judicial Council. Explains that the changes would only take place once the justices graduate or*

*retire. Would stay at nine justices, and naturally lower to five. Also notes quorum would drop to 3, the current quorum is 7 and would be much easier at 3 members for quorum than 7. Believes that 9 members are too many members for the work that they do. Note that UNR's council also has 5 Justices with much more case work in comparison to UNLV's justice system which only has 2 case work.*

*Chair Brooks asks president Odunze about council members' work. How would council work if case work would increase.*

*President Odunze responds that there are stopgaps to prevent cases being made, such as the Internal Affairs committee.*

*Senate President Flores, adds that due to difficulty with quorum with the current 9 justices it caused cases to take longer.*

*Senate Curry adds that with 5 seats it would make picking justices more competitive*
