Senator Morfinez-Solis- Suggests addition of reusable water bottles.

Senator Hankins- Affirms \$55,000 left for one time sponsorships and \$14,000 in annual sponsorships.

Senator Curry- motions to amend EB 55-06, Section 2, redacts motion.

Senator Curry- Moves to amend EB 55-06, Section 2, "Each April, an amount of (\$8,000) eight thousand dollars from the CSUN One- Time Sponsorship Budget Line, received from student fees, shall be allocated toward the purchase of Gatorade beverages sunscreen, and hand fans products to be disbursed at the CSUN Student Union Front Desk and Student Wellness and Recreational Center (SRWC) Rebel Wellness Zone."

Senator Coss- Seconds motion.

Senator Perez Martinez- Disagrees with Senator Curry's motion. States the project should be from the annual budget.

Senator Curry- States they just want to ensure the project is successful and want to test it before adding it to the annual budget.

Senator Hubshman- Agrees with Senator Curry, wants to see student's interest.

Senator Perez Martinez- States there may not be money again for the reallocation for the one time sponsorship again.

Sensor Montoya is present at 6:30 pm, 18 Senators are present.

Senator Le- States the fans are not necessary for the project. Agrees with one time funding.

Senator Morfinez-Solis- Agrees with Senator Curry for one time funding.

Senator Perez Martinez- Talks about the funding for a trip as University Initiatives often funds location projects.

Senator Brooks- Agrees with Senator Perez Martinez, doesn't think trips should be funded from sponsorship budget. Talks about funding trips for RSOs.

Senator Hankins- States it is the first time the University Initiatives Committee is funding something like this. Points out funding for one time sponsorships.

Senator Tuitele returns from a point of personal privilege at 7:10 pm.

Senator Coss- Doesn't agree with funding trips through University Initiatives.

Senator Hubshman- Asks if the department can fund the trip on its own.

Anne White- Talks about the need for external funding.

Senate President Flores- States there is nothing in the bylaws that talk about funding trips through University Initiatives. Reads off bylaws regarding recurring sponsorships. Talks about representing underrepresented groups.

Senator Brooks- States they are not opposed to the project, and talks about starting this kind of funding through University Initiatives. States the funds should be cut in half to only fund for students.

Senator Curry- States they do not want RSOs to feel like they are less than departments.

Issac Culin- Comments in favor of the trip.

Senator Morfinez-Solis- Talks about hardships of international students.

Senator Perez Martinez- Shows favor of cutting funding in half. Asks the presenter about the funding being cut in half.

Anne White- States trip would not occur if the funding was cut in half. Talks about the hardships of international students.

Senator Hubshman- States there are no bylaws that guide on how to fund RSOs versus departments. States there is no bylaws saying not to fund it, states no bylaws stating that the Ways and Means operating policy should be applied to this case.

SPPT Ibarra Lira- States this is for a department, not an RSOs. States it is up to the discretion of the Senate since there are no bylaws. Is in favor of funding the bill.

Vice President Tolano- Agrees with SPPT Ibarra Lira. States the sponsorship should be treated differently than an RSO.

Senate President Flores- Talks about department needs from CSUN and representing all students.

Anne White- States trip is for students.

President Odunze- Talks about supporting international students and fiscal versus emotional impact.

Senator Curry- Shows concern for a department asking for supplemental funding for a trip that many RSOs ask to go on. Wants to apply Ways and Means guidelines.

Senator Brooks- Agrees with Senator Curry. Talks about UNLV, eh club and funding cultural trips at 50%.

Senator Morfinez-Solis- Talks about funding of an RSO going to both Ways and Mean and University Initiatives.

Senator Navarro Mendoza- States the funding is completely different from RSOs. Show favor towards the bill.

Associate Director Munoz- Agrees with Senator Navarro Mendoza, talks about the difference between RSOs versus departments.

Attorney General Rejas- Refers to bylaws and Ways and Means funding applying to "UNLV entities." Refers to bylaws and University Initiatives funding. States to treat the bill as passed through University Initiatives.

President Odunze- States the trip will not occur if the funding is cut in half. The trip either has to be funded in full or not.

Senator Hankins took a point of personal privilege at 7:40 pm.
