AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OFFICE OF SERVICE, LEADERSHIP, AND LEARNING

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 27,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; AND

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate and represent the needs of all undergraduate students; AND

WHEREAS, CSUN makes it its mission to “to provide resources to enhance the student experience, help build community on campus, and empower leadership skills”.

WHEREAS, the Office of Service, Learning, and Leadership (SLL) makes its mission to create curricular and co-curricular experiences for participants to discover self, learn in the community, and influence systems while pursuing social justice.

WHEREAS, the Office of Service, Learning and Leadership offers opportunities for all UNLV students to develop essential leadership skills and recognition for their community service efforts.

WHEREAS, the Serve & Lead Mini-Con, a one-day leadership conference, is designed to help college students connect the experiences that shape them on campus with careers and callings that await them.

WHEREAS, the UNLV Impact Awards, presented by the Office of Service, Learning, and Leadership, “seeks to recognize individual students, groups of students, and student organizations whose leadership and service advances learning, justice, and social change within the community.”

WHEREAS, the University Initiatives committee (under the Legislative Branch of CSUN) serves with the purposes of improving the UNLV campus and community, addressing and advocating for undergraduate student interests, needs, and concerns related to (but not limited to) health, safety, diversity, social justice, and sustainability; **AND**

WHEREAS, the UNLV CSUN University Initiatives Committee was provided \$30,000 for New One-Time Sponsorships in order to be appropriated for sponsorships available within the UNLV community; **AND**

WHEREAS, after discussion and approval from committee members during University Initiatives Committee Meeting 56-06, funds been approved for reallocation within the FY2026 CSUN Budget for an amount not to exceed \$4,000.00 ; **AND**

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: CSUN shall appropriate \$4,000.00 **one-time** (1) sponsorship for the Office of Service, Leadership, and Learning for the 2025-2026 academic year. This allocation will reflect the CSUN Scholarship program for the 2025-2026 academic year only. After the 2025-2026 academic year, the Office of Service, Leadership, and Learning will no longer receive funding from CSUN.

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED: The CSUN University Initiatives Committee may choose to provide again funds for the Office of Service, Leadership, and Learning from the One-time Sponsorship Scholarship Funds in future years if the committee chooses to do so.
