SENATE BILL 56-39

**AN ACT TO ESTABLISH CHAPTER 1219: UNLV FINE ARTS WALK
SPONSORSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

WHEREAS, under Chapter 1200 of Title XII of the CSUN Bylaws, the CSUN Sponsorship Fund is established to provide recurring annual financial support to UNLV entities; **AND**

WHEREAS, Section 10 under Chapter 1200 of Title XII of the CSUN Bylaws establishes the ability to create new sponsorships; **AND**

WHEREAS, the University Initiatives committee (under the Legislative Branch of CSUN) serves with the purposes of improving the UNLV campus and community, addressing and advocating for undergraduate student interests, needs, and concerns related to (but not limited to) health, safety, diversity, social justice, and sustainability; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN sponsorships play a vital role in supporting essential UNLV entities and their operations that positively impact the undergraduate student body; **AND**

WHEREAS, the CSUN University Initiatives Committee shall review the request for the establishment of the UNLV Fine Arts Walk Sponsorship on March 26th, 2026, during UI 56-07; **AND**

WHEREAS, after being seen by the University Initiatives Committee during UI 56-07, the sponsorship shall have been approved for establishment, with funding of an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00;

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED that “Chapter 1219: UNLV Fine Arts Walk Sponsorship” is established and added to the CSUN Bylaws as written under Addendum B; **AND**

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, CSUN shall appropriate an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00 from the CSUN FY2025-2026 “New/Existing Sponsorships” budget in order to establish the UNLV Fine Arts Walk Sponsorship.

CHAPTER 1219: UNLV FINE ARTS WALK SPONSORSHIP

SECTION 01: PURPOSE

- A. To establish an annual funding mechanism for the UNLV Fine Arts Walk event, overseen by the UNLV College of Fine Arts.
- B. Allocated funds shall be utilized to subsidize the operational and logistical expenses of the UNLV Fine Arts Walk event, helping to cover essential operating costs such as (but not limited to): catering for free public distribution, venue reservation fees, event programming, and provisioning of tabling materials for organizations.

SECTION 02: FUNDING

- A. Once per fiscal year, an amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) from the CSUN sponsorship budget shall be transferred to the UNLV College of Fine Arts.
- B. It shall be under the discretion of the UNLV College of Fine Arts to utilize the funds as deemed necessary in order to facilitate the most optimal execution of the UNLV Fine Arts Walk event.

SECTION 03: REQUIREMENTS

- A. Once per fiscal year, a representative from the UNLV College of Fine Arts shall provide a report to the CSUN University Initiatives committee regarding (but not limited to) the following information: active fiscal-year spending report, upcoming fiscal-year budget plan, relevant statistics/data, accomplishments, operations/activities, etc.
- B. CSUNs name and/or official logo shall be featured prominently on all presentations and marketing materials related to the UNLV Fine Arts Walk event.
 - 1. Marketing materials shall be defined as any item(s) designed and utilized to promote the UNLV Fine Arts Walk event. Examples of such marketing materials include (but are not limited to): flyers/posters/advertisements, apparel, promotional merchandise, etc.

- C. All funds disbursed to the College of Fine Arts under this sponsorship shall be utilized exclusively for the planning, promotion, and execution of the UNLV Fine Arts Walk event. Any expenditure of these funds must be demonstrably related to the operations of this event.
- D. Any funds not expended by the UNLV College of Fine Arts for any and all purposes outlined within this chapter shall be returned to the CSUN sponsorship budget on or before January 31st of each fiscal year.
