AN ACT TO AMEND SENATE BILL 55-121

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate for the needs of undergraduate student organizations; **AND**

WHEREAS, the student organization has completed all of the necessary documentation as required by the Ways and Means Committee and the Ways and Means Operating Policy; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Raising Our AANHPI Rights provided a Reallocation budget under Addendum A; **AND**

WHEREAS, the CSUN Ways and Means Committee will review the request on March 31, 2026 during WM 56-05; **AND**

WHEREAS, the CSUN Ways and Means Committee allocated funds previously for the Raising Our AANHPI Rights on September 26, 2025 for Senate Meeting 55-27 in Ways and Means 55-19 Under Addendum A; **AND**

WHEREAS, the student organization, after being seen by the Ways and Means Committee, has been approved for an amount not to exceed \$2,922.44; **AND**

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, CSUN shall amend Senate Bill 55-121, as outlined in Addendum A, to authorize Raising Our AANHPI Rights to reallocate funds in adherence with the Ways and Means Operating Policy for CSUN FY 25-26
