RSO leader explains the changes to the budget (removal of tote bags and requests money for the events they will be holding)

Senator Beals states that the Operating Policy states that the committee can not pay for subscriptions, so we must remove that line item.

Chair Curry asks RSO where they would like the subscription money to go instead.

Senator Coss states that the budgets do not match up with the original approved budget and the reallocation.

Chair Curry asks RSO what they would like to spend that extra money on.

RSO leader states that they would most likely have to just send a check with the money

that is left over.

Senator Coss asks if the RSO would like more LSAT book vouchers.

RSO leader approves.

Chair Curry states that the budget is now balanced to match the approved budget from last session.

Senator Mohen is present at 6:07 PM with 10 senators present.

Senator Mohen asks if the vouchers expire.

Senator Coss states that the vouchers are reimbursements of the LSAT cost.
