**AN ACT TO AMEND THE CSUN BYLAW CHAPTER 1215 GRAD REBEL
ADVANTAGE SPONSORSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 25,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI..D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

WHEREAS, the University Initiatives committee (under the Legislative Branch of CSUN) serves with the purposes of improving the UNLV campus and community, addressing and advocating for undergraduate student interests, needs, and concerns related to (but not limited to) health, safety, diversity, social justice, and sustainability; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN sponsorships play a vital role in supporting essential UNLV entities and their operations that positively impact the undergraduate student body; **AND**

ADDENDUM A

CHAPTER 1215: GRAD REBEL ADVANTAGE SPONSORSHIP

SECTION 01: PURPOSE

A. To provide permanent supplemental funding for the Grad Rebel Advantage Program.

SECTION 02: FUNDING

A. In the beginning of each Fall semester, an amount of ten thousand (\$10,000) from the CSUN Sponsorship Budget received from student fees shall be transferred to the UNLV Grad Rebel Advantage Program to the CSUN Sponsorship budget.

SECTION 03: REQUIREMENTS

A. Each end of the fiscal year, ~~all money~~ the money disbursed towards the Grad Rebel Advantage Program (\$10,000) ~~must be used for the following items~~ may be used towards but not exclusively for:

1. Rebel Research and Mentorship (RAMP) Undergraduate Awards
2. Cohort Incentives and Scholarships
3. Cohort Mentorships
4. Program Workshops

~~B.~~ It shall be under the discretion of the Grad Rebel Advantage Program to utilize the remaining funds as deemed necessary in order to facilitate the most optimal execution for this program.

~~B.~~C. An additional program requirement option for UNLV undergraduates under workshops is attending a CSUN hosted workshop or educational session/forum as determined by the program coordinator.

~~C.~~D. Prior to March 31st, a representative from the Grad Rebel Advantage Program must provide a report to CSUN, in person or through email detailing the usage and impact of CSUN funding

and a report of overall department updates from the past year.

1. CSUN's name and/or logo shall be prominently displayed on presentations of workshops, programming, etc.
