SENATE BILL 56-57

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE DONATED FUNDS TO THE G.R.A.N.T.S PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 27,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate and represent the needs of all undergraduate students; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate for the financial needs of undergraduate students through the means of scholarships and G.R.A.N.T.S; **AND**

WHEREAS, the UNLV CSUN Scholarships and Grants Committee was donated \$4,000 in donations in order to be utilized for the Scholarship & Grants mission that will be available within the UNLV undergraduate student community; **AND**

WHEREAS, after discussion and approval from committee members during S&G 56-07 funds have been approved for reallocation within the FY 2026 CSUN Budget for an amount not to exceed \$4,000 from the donor fund; **AND**

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, CSUN shall appropriate \$9,000 **one** (1) time for the CSUN G.R.A.N.T.S Program for the 2026 G.R.A.N.T.S Program cycle, consisting of \$5,000 from the original

G.R.A.N.T.S Program funding amount and \$4,000 from the donor fund. This allocation will reflect the CSUN Scholarship program for the 2025-2026 academic year only. After the 2025-2026 academic year, the G.R.A.N.T.S program will revert to the original \$5,000 amount.

ADDENDUM A

The CSUN Scholarships & Grants was donated an amount of \$4,000 to utilize for the committee's mission and values in actively advocating for the financial needs of undergraduate students through the means of scholarships and G.R.A.N.T.S. As the G.R.A.N.T.S program application period has closed, we would like to utilize the \$4,000 by adding it to our current budget for the G.R.A.N.T.S program sitting at \$5,000 in which for this round of G.R.A.N.T.S we would be able to fund more students totaling to \$9,000 to award.
