SENATE BILL 56-62

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE-TIME FUNDS FOR THE ELECTRONIC CHARGING TABLE SPONSORSHIP

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 27,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI..D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate and represent the needs of all undergraduate students; **AND**

WHEREAS, the University Initiatives committee (under the Legislative Branch of CSUN) serves with the purposes of improving the UNLV campus and community, addressing and advocating for undergraduate student interests, needs, and concerns related to (but not limited to) health, safety, diversity, social justice, and sustainability; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Student Union continues to undergo revitalization and improvement efforts aimed at enhancing student engagement, accessibility, campus community, and the overall student experience; **AND**

WHEREAS, CSUN supports ongoing Student Union improvement initiatives and recognizes the importance of contributing to these efforts through smaller student-centered projects and sponsorship opportunities; **AND**

WHEREAS, the initiative would improve the overall Student Union environment by encouraging student engagement, convenience, and accessibility; **AND**

WHEREAS, students frequently rely on personal electronic devices for academic success, communication, studying, and campus involvement; **AND**

WHEREAS, accessible charging stations support commuter students and students who spend extended hours on campus for classes, studying, and student involvement activities; **AND**

WHEREAS, maintaining access to electronic devices is essential for academic participation, Canvas access, communication, and coursework completion; **AND**

WHEREAS, the proposed charger table initiative is intended to serve as a small-scale, one-time sponsorship project to evaluate student interest, usage, and overall need before considering larger-scale funding or implementation methods through other funding avenues; **AND**

WHEREAS, utilizing a one-time sponsorship allows CSUN to responsibly assess the effectiveness and practicality of charging tables within the Student Union while minimizing financial impact and maintaining fiscal responsibility; **AND**

WHEREAS, the charging tables are designed for long-term durability, require minimal maintenance, and include a five-year warranty from the manufacturer; **AND**

WHEREAS, the Student Union Senior Leadership Team (SLT) has agreed to oversee the ongoing maintenance and operational management of the charging tables following installation; **AND**

WHEREAS, any future costs associated with charger repairs, replacements, upgrades, or updates beyond the initial one-time sponsorship shall be the responsibility of the Student Union SLT team and shall not require additional CSUN funding; **AND**

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, that CSUN shall appropriate \$1,680.02 in one-time funding for the purchase, installation, and branding of two high-top charging tables and accompanying seating for the Student Union during the 2025–2026 academic year.

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED, that the charging tables shall be placed in designated high-traffic areas on the first and second floors of the Student Union to maximize student accessibility and use.

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED, that CSUN branding shall be incorporated into the charging tables to promote student engagement and campus identity.
