Senate President Flores- Motions to extend Candidate De Lima's questioning time by 5 minutes.

President Odunze- Seconds the motion.

President Odunze moves to a voiced vote to approve the motion to extend Candidate De Lima's questioning time by 5 minutes.

With a vote of 3-0-0, the motion is approved and the candidate's time is extended by 5 minutes.

Associate Justice Martinez- Asks about event ideas.

Candidate De Lima- Wants to create events that promote civic engagement.

Associate Justice Karagdag- Asks about experience and ideas with social media.

Candidate De Lima- States they have experience with creating a newsletter. Wants to promote the Judicial Council on social media more.
