### **C. Consideration of an Internal Affairs Complaint against Vanessa (Vee) King**

A complaint has been submitted against Senator Vanessa (Vee) King. The committee will decide if the complaint warrants an Internal Affairs Investigation.

*Chair Le gives the committee some context regarding the Complaint Process as it relates to Internal Affairs' scope of practice*

*Senator Shelton Lott asks questions regarding the addition of the Internal Affairs Operating Policy into the supplemental materials*

*Attorney General Rejas responds that the Internal Affairs Operating Policy can be found in the UNLV CSUN Website*

*Advisor Hare adds that it can be found in the Governing Documents of the UNLV CSUN Website.*

*Chair Le reads the complaint submitted to the Internal Affairs Committee. The full complaint can be found in the Supplemental Materials.*

*Chair Le gives a prescribed amount of time to both the complainant and respondent to present their case.*

*Senate President Flores gives a presentation regarding the submitted complaint, including a background of the requirement for all senators to complete Office Hours. Senate President Flores states that Senator King has accumulated various office hours and has not made it up, resulting in an Internal Affairs complaint. She states that she does not seek a severe consequence but provides a list of acceptable consequences.*

*Senator King states that she is unable to speak and asks Chair Le to read an email as submitted into the supplemental materials.*

*Chair Le reads an email as evidence provided by Senator King. Email as evidence can be found in the accompanying supplemental materials.*

*Senator Shelton Lott asks a question regarding voting on the agenda item and whether it would launch an investigation.*

*Chair Le clarifies that the committee first votes on whether it warrants an Internal Affairs Investigation.*

*Senator Curry states that the committee should take Senator King's word and trust that she can fulfill her office hour duties.*

*Senator Shelton Lott asks if Attorney General Rejas is able to clarify on launching an investigation.*

*Attorney General Rejas responds that Senator Curry refers simply to the fact that there was a violation, and the agenda item is asking whether or not there was a violation of the CSUN Governing Documents.*

*Chair Le provides a violation according to the UNLV CSUN Bylaws.*

*Senator Shelton Lott states that a violation has been made.*

*Attorney General Rejas lets the committee know that a motion is needed.*

*Attorney General Rejas clarifies that the agenda item needs to be decided whether or not a violation has been made and move into a period of discussions regarding the sanction, or the motion needs to be made to move into discussions regarding the sanction*
