Other General Degree Requirements

- Minimum 120 credits required to graduate
- 42 credits must be Upper Division (courses numbered 300 or higher)
- Minimum 30 Upper Division credits must be completed at UNLV
- 50% of Department requirements must be completed at UNLV
- Last 30 credits must be earned as a declared major in the College of Liberal Arts
- 2.0 Cumulative UNLV GPA required to graduate
- Maximum 4 credits of PEX can be used towards graduate requirements
- At least one Multicultural and one International course must be completed. Students can combine these courses with others in their major or the General Education.

Choose one pair of courses to be taken in sequence:

HIST 101 and 102 – United States History

HIST 105 and 106 – European Civilization

Geographic Breadth

Choose one of these options:

HIST 151 – Intro to Japanese Civilization

HIST 212 – History of East Asia II

HIST 232 – History of Africa III

Or an additional Historical Survey course not already taken from the above options.

Global or Multicultural

Choose one of these options:

HIST 103 – Global Problems in Historical Perspective

HIST 110 – History of Multiculturalism in America

HIST 229 – Drugs and Security in the Americas

HIST 260 – Intro to Native American History

HIST 267 – Intro to the History of the Jewish People

Historical Methods Requirements

These three courses must be taken in order:

HIST 251 – Intro to Historical Methods (complete at least one HIST course first)

HIST 351 – History Workshop (requires grade of C- or higher in HIST 251 first)

HIST 451 – Capstone Research Seminar (take in senior year; requires C- or higher in both HIST 251 and 351 and at least 9 credits of HIST coursework first)
