EXECUTIVE RESOLUTION 56-01

AN ACT IN SUPPORT OF THE FY27 STUDENT FEE ALLOCATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (CSUN) represents all 27,000+ undergraduate students enrolled at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas; and

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Consolidated Students of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, under the authority of CSUN Constitution VI.D.01, is “empowered to enact any legislation that falls under the jurisdiction of CSUN”; AND

WHEREAS, CSUN must actively advocate and represent the needs of all undergraduate students; AND

WHEREAS, during the January 2026 NSHE Board of Regents meeting, the Board approved a multi-year increase in student fees; AND

WHEREAS, in FY27, that fee increase is projected to generate \$5.2 million of previously unbudgeted student fee revenue for the state-supported operating budget; AND

WHEREAS, The FY27 Student Fee Allocation Plan outlines UNLV’s plan for allocating these funds after consultation with student leaders and has aligned these funds to support student success initiatives; AND

WHEREAS, the spending plan includes initiatives prioritized and advocated for by CSUN including: Alumni Mall Shade Improvements, Wheeled Conveyance Infrastructure, Food Pantry Relocation & Buildout, Technology Loan Program/MacBook Replacement, as well as supporting student focused initiatives like Enterprise AI and improving Computing Labs & Classrooms Hardware Needs that will benefit UNLV students long-term; AND

WHEREAS, it is important that CSUN supports the university when the institution champions student led initiatives and fosters continued collaboration through UNLV's shared-governance process;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the CSUN Student Government of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas formally expresses its full support for the FY27 Student Fee Allocation Plan and the allocation of the student fee revenues toward initiatives that enhance the student experience; AND

LET IT FURTHER BE RESOLVED, that the CSUN Student Government commends the university administration for engaging with student leaders throughout the development of their FY27 Student Fee Allocation Plan, their dedication to enhancing the student experience, and encourages continued collaboration with CSUN in future fee allocation decisions; AND
