President Odunze explains the changes proposed to the CSUN 27 Budget compared to the CSUN FY 26 Budget

Senator Beals asks about Line item 152, 130, whether or not both the new and existing sponsorships are combined into one budget line

President Odunze explains that they are combined because they removed the permanent sponsorships

Senator Beals asks how a sponsorship can be made permanent

President Odunze states that to make a sponsorship permanent, the sponsorship would go through

CSUN Discretionary, but no sponsorship is permanent this year, due to the recent tuition increase. If a sponsorship is successful, next year's board may decide if it will be permanent, so they are not tying too much money down

Advisor Dow explains that one-time funds may be used to increase an existing sponsorship or put the funds towards a new sponsorship

President Odunze explains that Rollover money goes to the IBA. \$100,000 of rollover funds go into the budget; the main areas are one-time sponsorship, one-time scholarship, and RSO funding. Once there are too many permanent sponsorships/scholarships, limit new initiatives for students

With a vote of 6-0-0, the CSUN FY 27 Budget has been approved.
