

CO-ENROLLMENT FORM

This form is used by a Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship (GGMS) recipient enrolled in a degree or certificate program at an one eligible institution to request credits taken at a second eligible institution be counted toward minimum enrollment requirements for the program. The "home" institution is the eligible college/university at which the student is enrolled in a program of study leading to a recognized degree or certificate. The "host" institution is any eligible institution where the student may be co-enrolled in coursework and the credits will be transferred back to the home institution. A co-enrolled student must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits between both institutions. [NRS 396.930, Sec. 1(e)(3)]
