

UNLV School of Architecture building access and office closure

The ARC Building and workshops/computer labs are now closed.

Governor Sisolak issued a third Emergency Directive. He has now officially directed all non-essential businesses in Nevada to close, effective through April 16, 2020.

This affects School of Architecture's staffing and building access.

Effective March 23rd, the School of Architecture office will be closed until April 19, 2020.

The situation will be reassessed in mid-April.

Our administrative assistants will not be in the office and have transitioned to working remotely from home. The Architecture building is closed and not accessible. The campus is currently open only to provide essential services, i.e., Police Services and essential Facilities.

The Governor's Emergency Directive outlines penalties for non-compliance.
