- This is the recommended course sequence to complete a full-time, two-year Traditional Degree program.
- Part-time students should take required courses first. All required courses must be completed prior to the semester when you take the comprehensive exam (e.g., if taking the comprehensive exam in the spring semester, all required courses must be completed by the previous fall semester).
- CRJ Approved Elective: Any criminal justice graduate level courses (600-700 level) or approved outside electives. Up to 6 credits of outside electives can be taken with approval.
- If you take 3-6 credits in summer, you may only need to take 6-9 credits in the following fall or spring semester.
