

Academic Department Internships

Each academic department at UNLV may have their own criteria for approving internship sites and awarding credit to students. Academic credit internships are most appropriate for upper-level students who are seeking an experience closely connected to their major. Students are not typically permitted to enroll in credit internships outside of their majors. All unpaid internships are required to be for credit.
