3. Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
4. Must have sophomore class standing during the current academic year (going into junior year)
5. Must enroll as a full time student at UNLV during the following Fall and Spring semesters and must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA during the scholarship period

The scholarship recipient is asked to attend the Alumni Association Scholarship Recognition Luncheon and the Greenspun College of Urban Affairs (GUA) Award Ceremony, typically held in late April in the GUA Auditorium.
