About us

- Founded in 2002 and graduated 1,116 general dentists since the first graduating class in 2006.
- Receives more than 1,800 applications each year for only 80 positions in the predoctoral program.
- Academic programs offered are Doctor of Dental Medicine (DMD), dual degrees DMD/Master's of Public Health and DMD/Master's of Business Administration, advanced standing Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS) program, Certificate advanced education residency programs in General Practice Residency, Pediatric Dentistry, and Orthodontics, and Ph.D. in Oral Biology.
- Employs more than 250 faculty and staff.
- Educates more than 320 predoctoral students and 52 dental residents each year.
- Faculty, resident, and student dentists complete approximately 70,000 patient visits each year.
- Provides comprehensive person-centered patient care in outpatient clinics for all stages of life from pediatric, adolescent, adult, and persons with special needs.
- Provides advanced oral health care in specialty dental clinics by licensed dentists who are full-time faculty members.
- Students provide oral health services to the community and engage with diverse segments of the public, which broadens their understanding of the social, cultural, economic, and public health impacts on oral health care delivery.
- Faculty and students actively engage in federally- and privately-funded research totaling more than \$11 million in external funding since 2005.
- Provided ~\$5.1 million in free care to more than 20,000 Nevadans between 2011 and 2019 through funded community outreach initiatives.
- Delivered >\$3.5 million in free care between 2011 and 2019 to children, homeless persons, veterans, women and children who are victims of domestic violence, those re-entering the workforce, and those with special needs through philanthropic support at on-site clinics.
