



Multicultural Program Scholarship Application ***College of Engineering Majors***

The primary mission of UNLV's Multicultural Program (MP) for Engineering, Sciences, Allied Health Sciences, Community Health Sciences, and Nursing is to assist and improve the retention and graduation rates of minority and underrepresented students in respective majors and programs at UNLV. The Multicultural Program Scholarship is one of the vehicles that the MP program uses to achieve its mission.

Multicultural Program Scholarship/College of Engineering Majors is open to the MP members in the College of Engineering.

Awards range from \$500 to \$2000 for both the fall and spring semesters and are awarded to applicants based on their scholastic performance, participation in MP activities, an essay submission, financial need and available funds.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the **Multicultural Program Scholarship/College of Engineering Majors**, applicants must:

- Be an active MP member which includes, but is not limited to, being a member of one of the MP student organizations, attending MP sponsored programs or activities, and volunteering for MP or College events.
- Be enrolled and maintain status as a full-time student and be making adequate progress towards the completion of an engineering, computer science, or construction management degree.
- Have a minimum overall grade point average of 2.75 out of 4.0 at the time of scholarship awarding.
- Maintain a minimum overall grade point average of 2.75 out of 4.0 for both the fall and spring semesters of the awarding period.

Application Deadline

The Applications must be received in the College of Engineering Advising Center by **4:00 PM, Friday, May 29, 2020**. Applications can be delivered personally or emailed to engineering.scholarship@unlv.edu. The College of Engineering Advising Center is on UNLV's main campus in the Thomas Beam Engineering (TBE) Complex, Building A in room A207.
