- All graduate assistants receive a 10% discount at the UNLV bookstore. Take a copy of your signed contract when you go to purchase your books.
- Once you have your UNLV student ID, you will need to activate it at the Circulation Desk at the Lied Library to access your library privileges.
- You will need your ACE account in order to use the computers in the student labs, this includes the Graduate Student Commons (LLB 2141). ACE accounts are created for students upon admission to UNLV. Students will receive an email to their personal email account with their ACE credentials and account setup instructions. 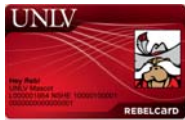
Services
