- Students graduating with University Honors must complete 31 HON prefixed credits.
- Above plan does not figure in waivers for AP, IB, or other dual enrollment credits.
- Some University Honors Requirements can be satisfied by courses taken within a student's major.
- Foreign language suggestions depend upon major, language placement, and if study abroad is planned.
- A pre-approved study abroad course may replace one HON 400-level seminar.
- All students must satisfy an International, Fine Arts and Multicultural requirement.
- University Honors students satisfy the International requirement with the foreign language requirement. Latin does not satisfy the International requirement.
- The following HON 400-level seminars can also satisfy their noted requirements:
 - HON 410 can satisfy the Social Science requirement (requires topic approval from major advising center).
 - HON 420 can satisfy the Fine Arts requirement.
 - HON 430 can satisfy the International requirement.
 - HON 440 can satisfy the Multicultural requirement.
