**EVERY
YEAR**

- Complete your FAFSA
- Archive your academic, extracurricular, and professional achievements
- Review scholarship opportunities from your major college
- Meet with your major college advisor
- Meet with your Honors College advisor

YEAR**

- Develop a relationship with your Honors Mentor
- Take UNLV Foreign Language Placement Test
- Explore major and career options (including graduate/professional schools)
- Consider Study Abroad options
- Construct a 2-year plan of study with your major and Honors College advisors
- Meet with appropriate Pre-Professional Advisors (if applicable)
- Attend Honors College community events (e.g., Kickball, Spring Picnic, etc.)
