




K-20 Education Collaborative Advisory Board: Our Audience


Based on the statement above, who do you believe is The Lincy Institute, Education Collaborative Advisory Board (ECAB) primary audience?




SHORT TERM ISSUES (6-18 months)




INTERMEDIATE TERM ISSUES (18-24 MONTHS)




LONG TERM ISSUES (24 MONTHS +)



ISSUES TO MONITOR




MOST IMPORTANT COMMUNITY EDUCATION ISSUE
