Notes:

- Applicants must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.75 (4.00=A) for the bachelor's degree or a minimum 3.00 (4.00=A) for the last two years (60 semester hours).
- Successful applicants need to have earned at least a B grade (or equivalent) in the prerequisite courses.
- Satisfactory GMAT or GRE score is required. Preference is given to applicants with GMAT scores above 550 (or the GRE equivalent).
- Applications can be submitted before all the admission requirements have been met, in which case admission may be granted conditional on the applicant successfully fulfilling these requirements before enrolling in the program.
- For international applicants, the minimum score is 80 for TOEFL (Internet-based test) or 6.5 for IELTS. <https://www.unlv.edu/graduatecollege/english-proficiency>
