FAST FACTS

All faculty, staff, and students are required to have a permit to park their vehicles on UNLV's campus.

Why?

UNLV is an urban institution centrally located in a densely populated section of the city. Parking allocations:

- Increase safety by ensuring that campus parking spaces are reserved for those attending classes, working, and conducting business at the university
- Assign a proportionate number of spaces to staff and students
- Reduce Co2 emissions by keeping high-volume traffic at the perimeter of campus



Did You Know?

Upon request, the Department of Police Services will provide safety escorts to walk students to their cars after dark. Call 702-895-3668 ext. 2 or use the [RebelSAFE app](#) to request this service.

Emergency phones equipped with 360-degree surveillance cameras are located throughout campus.

Parking and transportation services provides complimentary jump starts and tire inflation through the Motorist Assistance Program. Service is available Monday – Friday, 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. by calling 702- 895-1300.

Parking Enforcement Hours

Daily, 7 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.

Handicapped and Reserved parking are enforced 24 hours / seven days a week



Insider's Tips

* Parking spaces are in the highest demand Monday - Thursday, 10 a.m.- 2 p.m. The best places to park during this time are:

- * White Lot located to the west of the Thomas & Mack Center. Typically there are over 1,000 spaces available!
- * Lot T located on the northwest section of campus near the Stan Fulton Building
- * UNLV's campus hosts 1,900 events each year! When weekday events are held at the Thomas & Mack Center, the Tropicana Garage is reserved for student and faculty/staff permit holders
