



Faculty Senate Statement of Confidentiality

The need to maintain the integrity and credibility of the Faculty Senate Program Review Committee process and to ensure participation and cooperation of all involved requires confidentiality during the Faculty Senate Program Review Committee process. In order to maintain the integrity and credibility of the Faculty Senate Program Review Committee process and to protect the parties involved, it is understood that the individuals involved in a Faculty Senate Program Review Committee will keep confidential, except to those individuals who have a need and right to know, the names of all parties and witnesses, all documents and all testimony during the pendency of the Faculty Senate Program Review Committee. Failure of the parties to maintain confidentiality severely impacts the ability of the UNLV Faculty Senate Program Review Committee to perform its duties and responsibilities. Members of the UNLV Faculty Senate Program Review Committee perform a vital function on this campus. Because of this role, committee members are especially and specifically required to maintain confidentiality. Committee members shall not divulge to unauthorized persons any information obtained from observations, conversations or documentation of any sort regarding any matter brought before the committee for consideration. Further, committee members shall not publish or make public any information regarding any person involved with a matter before the committee.
