### Dos

- **Before** beginning laser operation:
  1. MAKE SURE
  2. SWITCH ON
  3. CHECK IF
  4. WEAR
  5. CHECK
- **After** ending laser operation, switch off "Laser in Use" warning light.

### DON'Ts

- ✓ **NEVER LOOK DIRECTLY INTO THE LASER PATH**
- ✓ **DON'T** place any parts of your body in defined path of the laser
- ✓ **DON'T** place flammable objects in the defined path of the laser
- ✓ **DON'T** put any reflective (specular or diffuse) surfaces
- ✓ **DON'T** wear jewelry or clothing with reflective surfaces (rings, shiny belt buckles, pendants, ID cards on lanyards) when working with laser beam
- ✓ **DON'T** enter the Laser Lab
- ✓ **DON'T** let any VISITOR enter
