



Learn to Swim Lesson Policies

- Learn to Swim sessions are four week sessions held on Saturdays.
- Infants must be at least 6 months of age to enroll in the Parent/Child class.
- Swim diapers must be worn by all participants that are not potty trained. The SRWC does not provide swim diapers.
- Participants over the age of 5 are not permitted to enter the opposite sex locker room. There is an all-inclusive locker room located next to the wet classroom and a unisex bathroom located across from the leisure pool.
- Parents are asked to sit in the designated area, which is on the ledge along the windowed wall.
- Parents need to stay on the pool deck during the entire lesson.
- If a child needs to use the restroom during a lesson, we will ask that the parent or guardian escort them.
- In order to begin on time, we ask that you arrive 15 minutes prior to class to allow time for changing.
- All general pool policies are effective during Learn to Swim sessions.
