Recommenders

We ask for recommendations from at least <u>three</u> people who can address your potential as a social work student and future social work professional. References should be from <u>professional</u> (not personal) sources and/or academic faculty (dated within the last two years), with the preferred recommendations as follows: one recommendation from the most recent employer in a social work position (if applicable) and one from an academic instructor (Social Work instructor, if applicable) if you have been in an academic setting in the past five (5) years. Please note that the person evaluating you needs to have been in a supervisory/evaluative position in relation to you and not someone like a co-worker, fellow student, pastor, or family member.

You will be asked to provide contact information about the three recommenders. Then a "Request for Recommendation" email will be generated to them asking them to complete the required recommendation information and upload it to the Grad Rebel Gateway via the "Start your recommendation" link in the email. The recommendation information includes a rating scale followed by a letter of reference typed directly into the (expanding) box provided electronically.
