For the June 5 sponsorship cycle, the committee approved 2 applications for a total of \$1,603.80 out of \$2910.76 requested. The May applications were ineligible for emergency funding. Of the June applications, 2 were considered ineligible and 2 were funded. The sponsorship committee has approximately \$3400 left for the remainder of the summer for emergency funding applications.
