NEW FACULTY: AN INVITATION TO APPLY FOR GRADUATE FACULTY STATUS (GFS)

All UNLV faculty who will be working with students at the graduate level must apply for Graduate Faculty Status. This includes teaching any graduate-level courses, mentoring graduate students, or serving on Graduate Advisory Committees. The online GFS application takes less than five-minutes to complete and requires applicants to upload their current Curriculum Vitae.

LEAVING FACULTY REQUIREMENT: PLEASE SUBMIT YOUR GFS LEAVING FORM

Graduate faculty who are leaving UNLV must submit a Graduate Faculty leaving form. The leaving form takes less than five-minutes to complete and does not require any uploads.

The leaving form indicates whether the graduate faculty member may continue unfinished work with students at the time of departure, continue on current Graduate Advisory Committees, and/or teach at the graduate level. It also indicates whether the faculty member may serve on future student committees after departure.

If the leaving form is not submitted within 30 days after departure from UNLV, we shall assume that the faculty member is not interested in maintaining any graduate faculty status at UNLV, continuing on any current Grad Advisory Committees, teaching at the grad level at UNLV, or engaging in future committee participation with students.
