### Instructions and Guidelines:

Unusual Enrollment History (UEH) is defined as the specific pattern of enrollment the U.S. Department of Education uses as a basis to identify students who have received a Federal Pell Grant and/or Federal Direct Loan over the past four academic years, but may not have earned academic credit. Your current financial aid ineligibility is due to this enrollment pattern.

Recognizing that there are instances in which a student may have extenuating circumstances which prevented them from earning academic credit, this appeal may be completed to make our office aware of those circumstances. The office will verify your academic history, review related appeals documentation submitted by you and determine if your financial aid eligibility can be approved. You will be notified of the Committee's review/decision by email to your Rebel email account and your [MyUNLV Communication Center](#).

**If appealing to gain financial aid eligibility for the fall 2021 semester, this appeal must be received by November 12, 2021.** Appeals received after this date will not be considered for the Fall 2021 semester.

**If appealing to gain financial aid eligibility for the spring 2022 semester, this appeal must be received by March 25, 2022.** Appeals received after this date will not be considered for the Spring 2022 semester.

Please allow up to 30 business days from receipt of your completed appeal for the Appeals Committee to carefully review your appeal.
