

Participants in the programs offered by the International Center for Gaming Regulation typically choose to stay at some of the nearby “business hotels”. However, nearly all of the hotels on the Las Vegas Strip are also within an easy 10-15 minute Uber or taxi ride.

Please be advised that [The Stan Fulton Building](#), home of the International Center for Gaming Regulation, is technically part of the UNLV campus and thus doesn’t have a “formal street address”. However, we are located on the corner of Flamingo & Swenson – an easily identifiable intersection. We suggest providing your taxi or Uber with these driving directions:

If you are on Flamingo heading EAST: drive across the Flamingo/Swenson intersection, past the building, and make the first right turn (about 150 yards from the intersection and just after the large solar panels) into the campus. Then take the first right turn and drive past the Rebel Recycling area to enter our parking lot.

If you are heading WEST on Flamingo: make a U-turn at Swenson and follow the instructions above.

If you are heading SOUTH on Swenson: make a left hand turn on Flamingo and follow the instructions above.

If you are heading NORTH on Swenson: make a right turn on Flamingo and follow the instructions above.
