

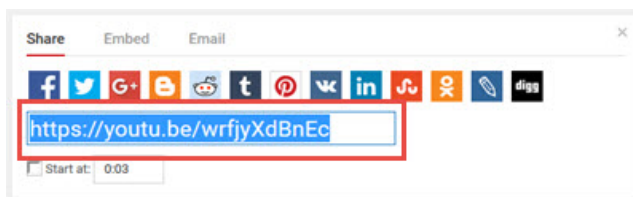
Embedding your YouTube video in WebCampus

Once you have created a video and uploaded it to your YouTube channel, you may embed it in a WebCampus (Blackboard) discussion, message, journal, blog or wiki. The following steps will guide you in the process, using a UNLV video and the discussion tool as an example.

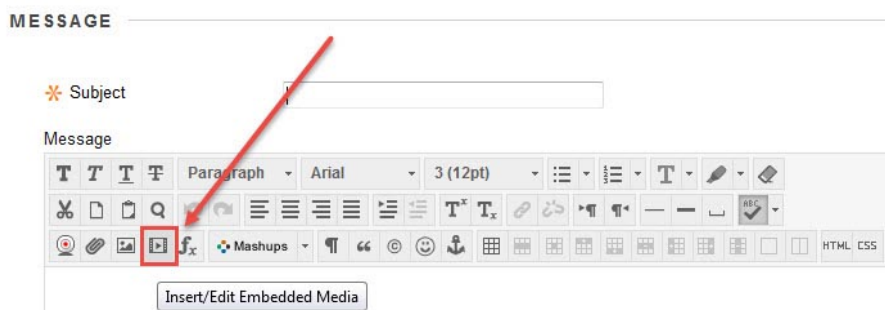
1. In YouTube, click “Share.”



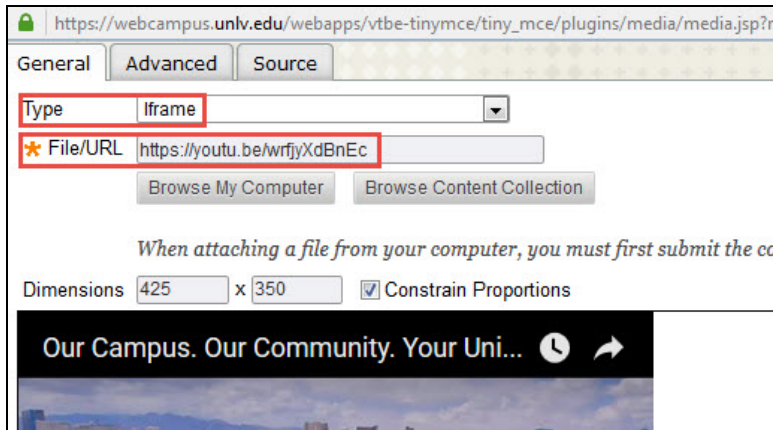
2. Copy the URL that is generated.



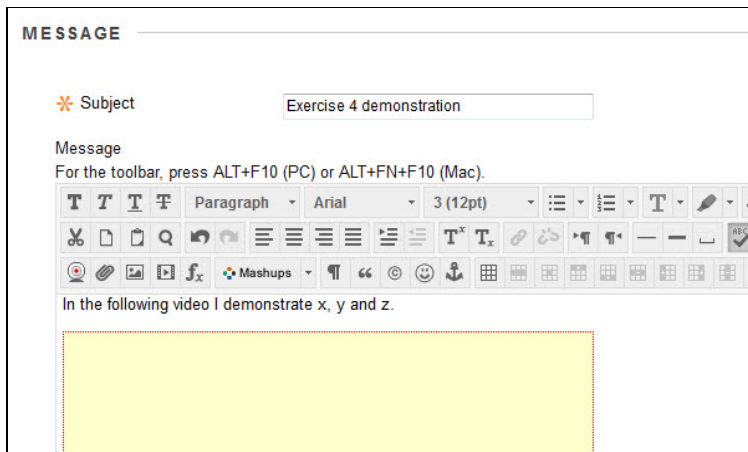
3. In WebCampus, go to Discussions. Click “Create Thread.” Then click the Insert/Edit Embedded Media button, which is located on the bottom row, fourth from the left.



4. In the Type menu select iframe. Paste the video's URL in the File/URL field.



5. Complete your thread. You may add text before or after the video. A yellow box will be a placeholder for the video until you click submit.



6. In the Discussion forum, click the thread to check out your vide
